Traditionally, the "**Dulzon Readings**" international conference series covers a wide range in the studies of peoples & languages of Russia and encompasses linguistic, ethnographic and archaeological studies of the minor ethnic groups of Russia.

The main scope of research interests includes the following aspects of synchronic and diachronic studies of languages and cultures of Siberian indigenous peoples: phonetics / phonology, morphology, syntax, lexical semantics, pragmatics with respect to common typological and areal perspectives, as well as issues on documenting, retaining and revitalizing the indigenous / endangered languages.

- Applications for organizing a panel session or roundtable within the conference should include: a clearly formulated topic, an outline of the planned discussion, and a list of participants (if known). Applications must be sent to the conference email address siblang@tspu.ru by August 20, 2025, with the subject line "DR-31 Panel" or "DR-31 Roundtable".
- Please, email your abstract(s) by August 20, 2025 to the conference email: siblang@tspu.ru with the subject line "Abstract DR-31". The abstracts should be 150-350 words, written in the Times New Roman font, size 12, with the DoulosSIL / CharisSIL font(s) for language examples, a reference list arranged alphabetically, interlinear space 1.5, and all margins 2.5 cm. Should files contain complex graphics, tables or potentially problematic glosses, we kindly ask to submit your abstracts in two formats: MS Word .doc(.docx) and Adobe .pdf. In-text references should be given in square brackets, e.g.,

[Kibrik, 1989: 10], [Payne, 1997; Stassen, 2009]. The reference list should be arranged in alphabetical order. Formatting of the reference list and footnotes should follow GOST standards (see: https://open-resource.ru/spisok-literatury/). The full name, affiliation of the author and the title of the report should be drawn up in accordance with the example:
